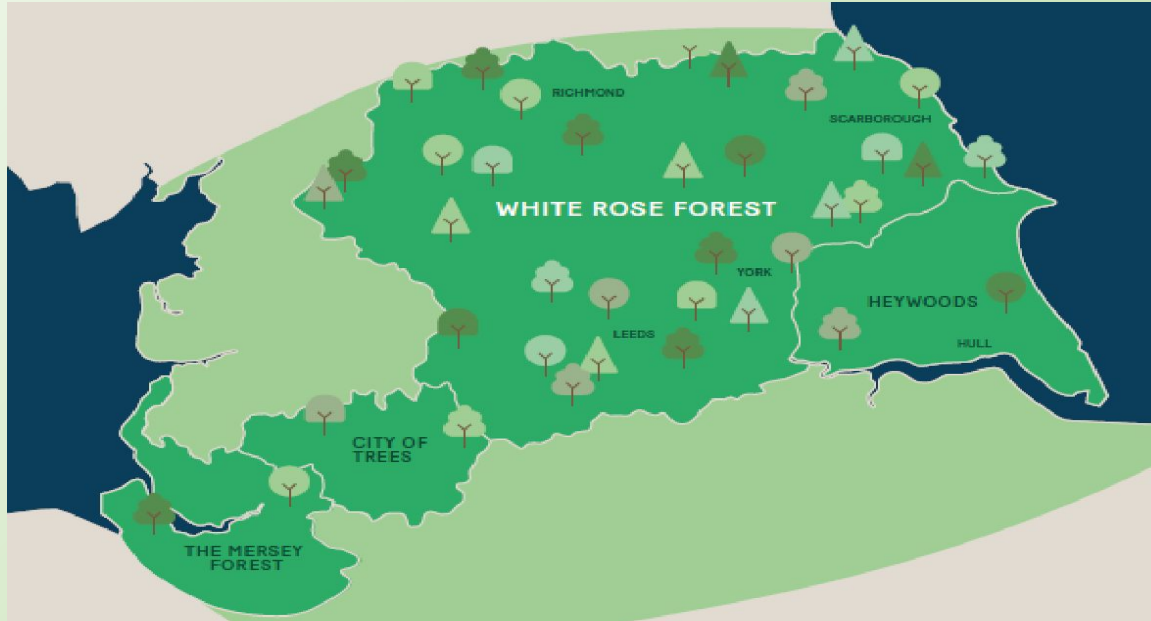

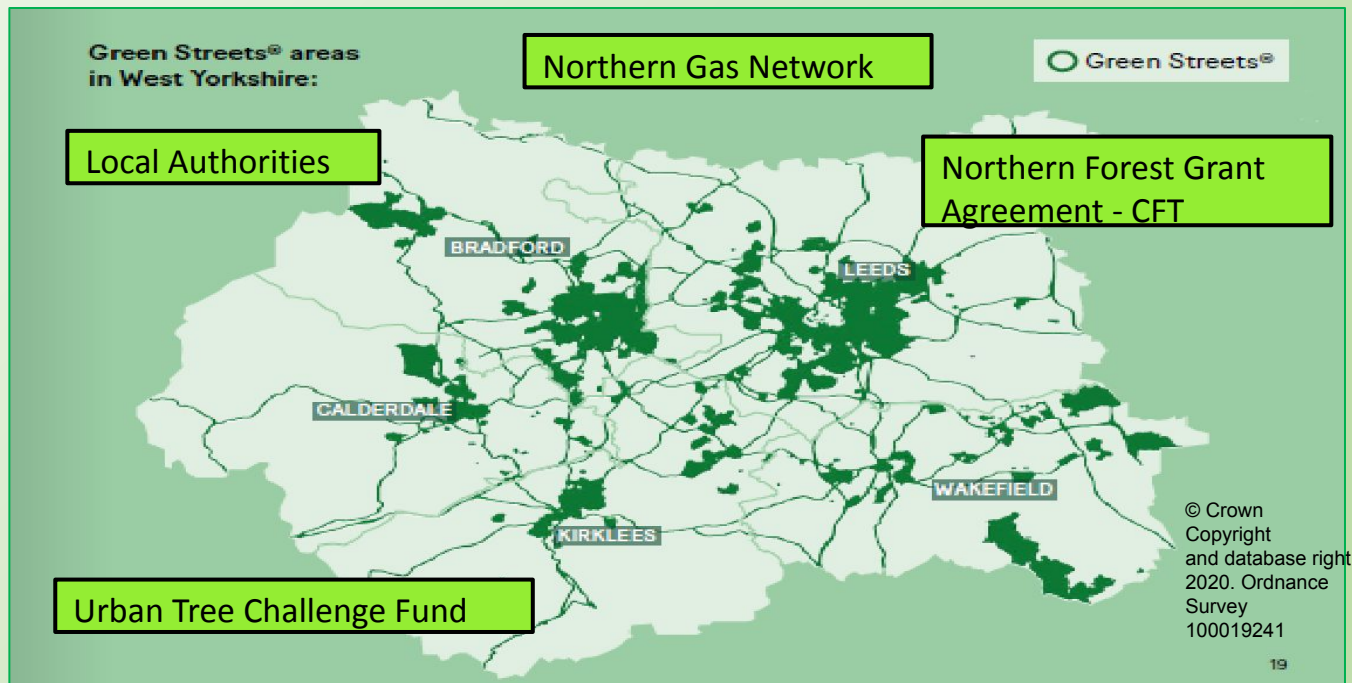
WRF Delivery Pathway: The Northern Forest



The White Rose Forest Action Plan 2021-25 sets out our aim to plant 3500 hectares of woodland by 2025 = approx. 7 million trees and almost 12% of the Government's national target.

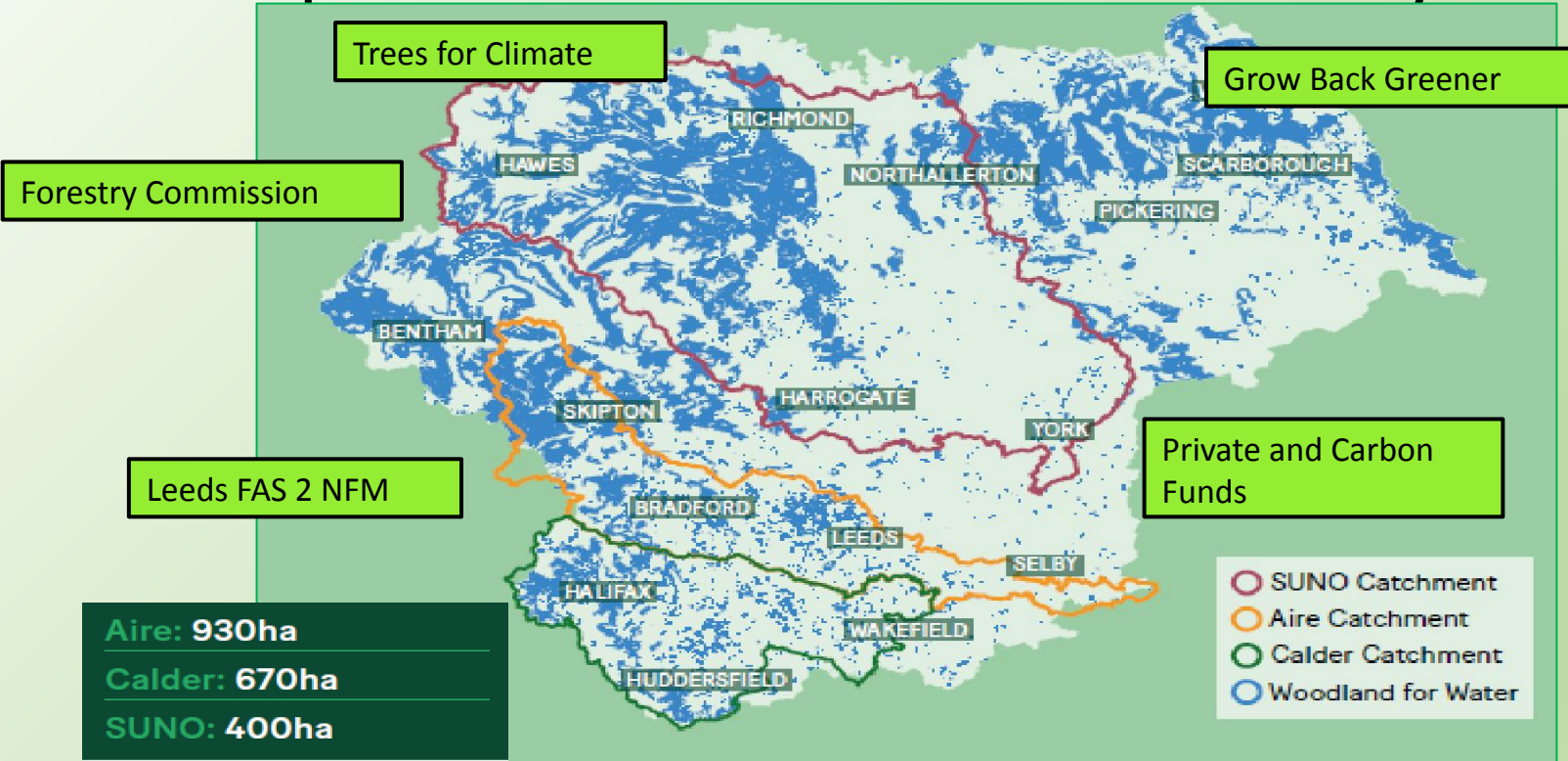
But we know that planting rates must increase much more beyond 2025
